

Galileo decode will be the mind blowing part of this post btw, but I'll go in order.


So if we assume this is a threat of sorts then what is this: "will you do the Fandango?"

Anubis is among the most ancient and important deities of the Egyptian pantheon: he presided over mummification and burial rites and was the Lord of the Necropolis. He was represented, in Egyptian iconography, as a jackal or as a man with the head of a jackal. This statue offers eloquent testimony to a syncretic divine figure, Anubis, who in the Roman context was assimilated to Mercury: the god with its jackal's head, with a small solar disc on a crescent moon between its ears, wears a short tunic, a cloak and shoes, and holds the caduceus in his hand, in his function as the ferryman of the dead to the Underworld ("psychopomp"). The statue, discovered in Anzio on land belonging to the Pamphilj family in 1749, was donated to Pope Benedict XIV and was transferred to the Gregorian Egyptian Museum in 1839.

Refracting telescope

Based only on uncertain descriptions of the first practical telescope which Hans Lippershey tried to patent in the Netherlands in 1608,^[40] Galileo, in the following year, made a telescope with about 3x magnification. He later made improved versions with up to about 30x magnification.^[41] With a Galilean telescope, the observer could see magnified, upright images on the Earth—it was what is commonly known as a terrestrial telescope or a spyglass. He could also use it to observe the sky; for a time he was one of those who could construct telescopes good enough for that purpose. On 25 August 1609, he demonstrated one of his early telescopes, with a magnification of about 8 or 9, to Venetian lawmakers. His telescopes were also a profitable sideline for Galileo, who sold them to merchants who found them useful both at sea and as items of trade. He published his initial telescopic astronomical observations in March 1610 in a brief treatise entitled *Sidereus Nuncius* (Starry Messenger).^[42]



Moon

On 30 November, 1609, Galileo aimed his **telescope** at the Moon.^[43] While not being the first person to observe the Moon through a **telescope** (English mathematician Thomas Harriot had done it four months before but only saw a "strange spottednesse"),^[44] Galileo was the first to deduce the cause of



What exactly is a telescope/SPYGLASS used for? Think about that for a moment.

So August 8th 1609 the Venetian senate (Italy/Vatican) examined Galileo's telescope – 17 days later he demonstrated it.

Officially recorded as the first telescopic observation of non Earth moons! And amazingly enough a german did the same thing independently the same week. (massive coincidence?)

Henry III was assassinated shortly thereafter, on 2 August 1589, by a fanatical monk.^[15]

When Henry III died, Henry of Navarre nominally became king of France. The Catholic League, however, strengthened by support from outside the country—especially from Spain—was strong enough to prevent a universal recognition of his new title. The Pope **excommunicated** Henry and **declared him devoid of any right to inherit the crown.**^[16] Most of the Catholic nobles who had joined Henry III for the siege of Paris also refused to recognize the claim of Henry of Navarre, and abandoned

Considered a usurper by some Catholics and a traitor by some Protestants, Henry became the target of at least 12 assassination attempts.^[3] Having faced much opposition

The king had a dozens assassination attempts made against him before one succeeded (probably why there was a sudden demand

Archbishop of Canterbury

The Queen's relationship with the Church of England was symbolised at the Coronation in 1953 when Her Majesty was anointed by the Archbishop of Canterbury and took an oath to 'maintain and preserve inviolably the settlement of the Church of England, and the doctrine, worship, discipline, and government thereof, as by law established in England'.

On the advice of the Prime Minister [The Queen appoints Archbishops, Bishops and Deans of the Church of England](#), who then swear an oath of allegiance and pay homage to Her Majesty. Church of England deacons and parish priests also swear an oath of allegiance to the Sovereign.

The Archbishop of Canterbury is the senior bishop and principal leader of the Church of England, the symbolic head of the worldwide Anglican Communion and the diocesan bishop of the Diocese of Canterbury. The current archbishop is Justin Welby.

The Queen is the Supreme Governor of the Church of England and appoints every position of power – Note the “Y” but this is another subject that requires other posts.
