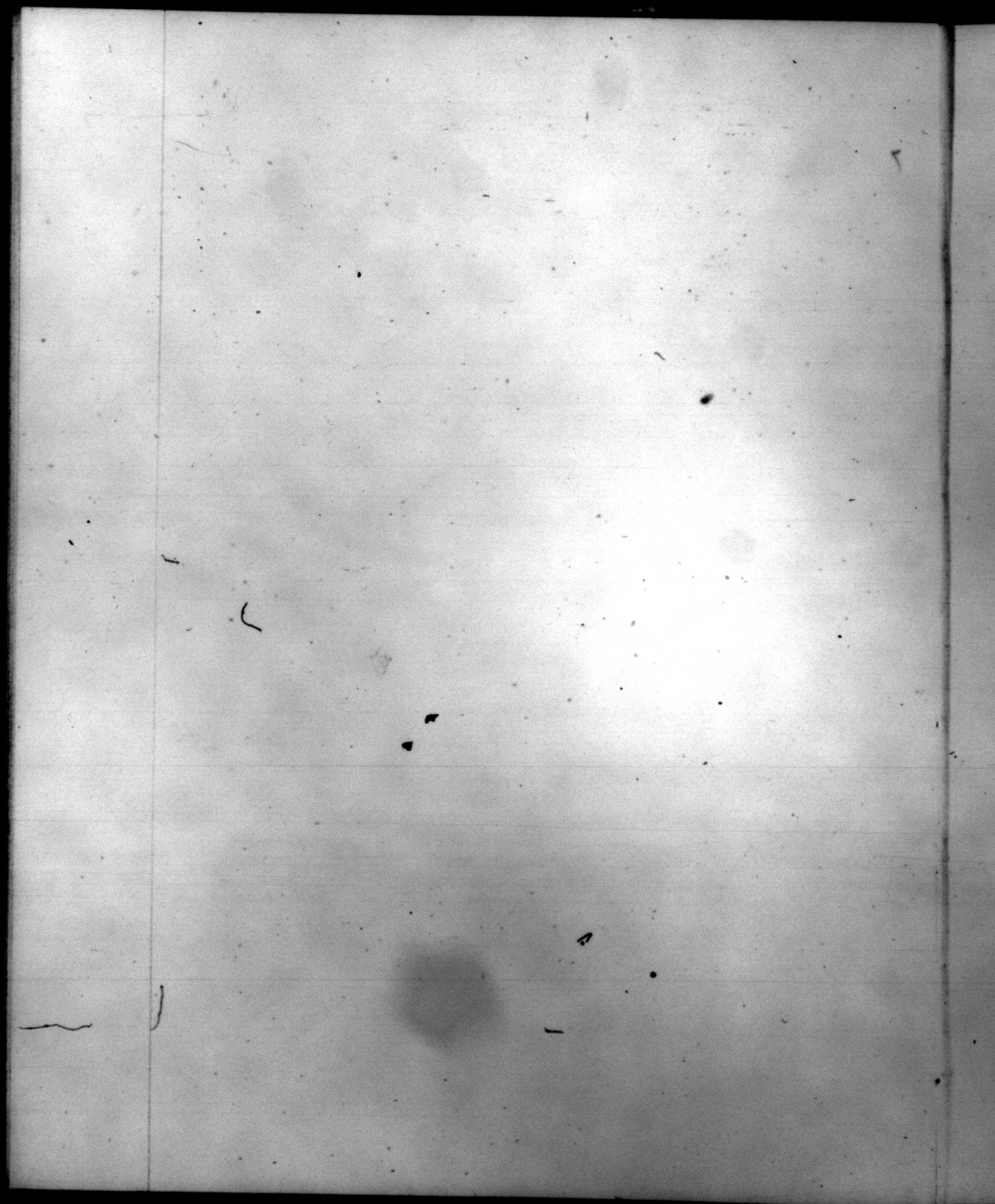
## Instruction in A.
